- Coaching of all athletes to create a fun and supportive learning environment that encourages development and excellence
- Daily practice planning
- Effective and continued communication with athletes, coaches and parents
- Maintain close liaison with the Head Coach
- Attend and participate in mandatory monthly coach meetings
- Attending all competitions and preparing athletes for competitions
- Semi-annual written progress reports to athletes at minimum.
- Attend all club training sessions & coaches meetings
- Working with the coaching team to learn and implement LTAD training into the Aquabelles program

Reporting directly to the Head Coach, the successful candidates must have a positive attitude, effective two way communication skills, leadership qualities, be enthusiastic and willing to challenge athletes at their respective levels. It is also critical that the successful candidate must be an advocate of team cohesion for both the athlete team as well as the coaching team.
