Important things to note:

➤ **Fees do not include duets and solos.**

These are extra, and will be charged in October once selections by coaches have occurred and approved by parents.

➤ **Payment terms must be adhered to.**

- Payment deadlines in your selected payment option are firm, with payment to be received by the Aquabelles in all cases, on or before the payment dates.
- 5% discount for full payment of team fees when paid on or before the first day of swimming.
- Bingos credits will be applied to your account in October, January, April and July after the bingos are worked. For any bingos worked approx. \$70 will be applied directly to the athlete's account.
